## **2.0 THE CURRICULUM**

### **2.0.1 Philosophy of the Programme**

In consonance with the University philosophy of searching for whole truth about God, Humanity and Nature the Master of Arts in History degree programme, aims at imparting knowledge for the truth and developing persons who will uphold ethics in research and work place.

### **2.0.2 Rationale**

The Master of Arts in History degree programme is designed to provide students with a wide scope of historical knowledge that would enable them to deal with contemporary human challenges. It stresses training of professional historians and development practitioners imbued with ethical values.

### **2.0.3 Programme Learning Outcomes**

On successful completion of the programme, learners shall:

- (a) Apply theoretical and methodological knowledge to address societal needs of historical nature.
- (b) Analyze, interpret and apply historical knowledge obtained in a variety of settings.
- (c) Exhibit appropriate historical skills and training in teaching, research and policy making.

## **2.1 Academic Regulations for the Programme**

### **2.1.1 Admission Requirements**

- (i) The common regulations governing the Masters degree in all Faculties of the Catholic University of Eastern Africa shall apply as stipulated in section 1.4
- (ii) Applicants who hold a Bachelor of Arts degree, with Upper Division Second Class Honours or its equivalent from recognized universities in History or related field shall be eligible for admission
- (iii) Applicants who hold a Bachelors of Arts degree, with Lower Division Second Class Honours or its equivalent from recognized universities in History or related field with practical field experience of not less than 3 years in relevant areas shall be eligible for admission.
