REVISED PROGRAMMES OF THE BACHELOR'S DEGREE IN EDUCATION

Justification:

The Bachelor's degree in education (BEd) programme was established to combat the problem of shortage of professionally trained teachers, especially in Africa.

Objectives:

- a) To train teachers for secondary schools and colleges with a view to forming a young generation that has a holistic view of the human person.
- b) To equip teachers with the necessary educational skills and methods for teaching in their area of specialization.

DEGREE REGULATIONS

I Entry Requirements:

Four-Year Programme

- a) The "Common Regulations" for all Bachelor's degree programmes in the University shall apply.
- b) The "Common Regulations", for all Bachelor's degree programmes in the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences of the University shall apply.
- c) Candidates from Kenya must have completed their secondary education and have obtained a minimum mean grade of C+ in the Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education examination.
- d) Candidates from other countries must satisfy the minimum requirements for university entry in their country.

Three-Year Programme

Candidates wishing to be admitted into the three year BEd degree programme must meet the following requirements:

- a) Kenya Advanced Certificate of Education or its equivalent with at least two (2) principal passes (at not less than grade D) for candidates from Kenya.
- b) Candidates from other countries must satisfy the minimum requirements of the University entry in their country.
- c) Candidates must meet the course requirement for admission in BEd to each particular department.

Two-Year Programme

To be admitted:-

- a) Candidates must be holders of a Diploma in Education with credits in education and two appropriate subjects or an equivalent qualification and three years teaching experience.
- b) Candidates must meet the course requirements for admission to each particular department.
