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2.0 THE CURRICULUM

2.1

Rationale

Bachelor of Church Management and Leadership aims at training evangelization Agents with a firm Management and Leadership, moral, ethical and Christian foundations to serve the Church and society.

Church Management and Leadership is an area of professional development, which still needs to be addressed in the Catholic Church and her institutions in Africa. A number of Church Managers of Church institutions are appointed to key positions without having had the benefit of prior training in Church Management and Leadership.

To meet the needs for training such Church personnel and prospective managers of Catholic Church institutions, the Catholic University of Eastern Africa now offers a bachelors degree in Church Management and Leadership in the Centre for Social Justice and Ethics.

The programme is designed for financial administrators, administrators of Church sponsored hospitals, schools and other not-for-profit organizations to build their skills in the areas of general management founded on professional expertise, social justice and ethics, good governance and integral human development.

2.2

Objectives of the Programme

The objectives of the programme are:

- i). Develop in students critical and analytical minds essential for formulation of just and ethical decisions.
- ii). Train evangelization agents with a firm moral and Christian background capable of carrying out their professional work within the Catholic Church institutions and in the wider society in a just and ethical way.

Target Groups

Financial Administrators, Administrators of Church sponsored hospitals, schools and other not-for-profit organizations.

2.4

Academic Regulations for the Programme

2.4.1 Admission Requirements

- a) The following common regulations for the bachelor's degree in the university shall apply.

Either

Be a holder of Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education (or equivalent examination) certificate with a minimum aggregate of C+;

or

Be a holder of Kenya Advanced Certificate of Education (or equivalent examination) certificate with a minimum of two principal passes and one subsidiary pass;

or

Be a holder of a diploma or professional certificate in a relevant discipline from an institution recognized by the Senate of the University;

or

Be a holder of any other qualification accepted by the Senate of the University as equivalent to any of the above.

- b) The Centre will admit:

- i) To the four-year programme, applicants with a minimum grade C Plain in English and Kiswahili in the Kenya Certificate of Secondary education Examination or its equivalent.

- ii) To the three-year programme, applicants with a credit in English or its equivalent at Ordinary level or holders of a diploma in Church Management and Leadership from the Centre for Social Justice and Ethics of the Catholic University of Eastern Africa.
