2.0 THE CURRICULUM

2.1 Rationale

Justice and Peace has been an urgent challenge facing Africa especially in the last years of the 20th century as well now. Most sectors are involved in lobbying for peace at all levels to sensitize people that violence does not solve conflicts but rather need for a democratic and a more humane way of doing it.

To meet the demand for a united response to the need for justice and peace in our societies in Africa, the Catholic University of Eastern Africa will offer a Bachelors degree in Justice and Peace for agents of Justice and Peace drawn from all sectors. The programme is geared towards assisting the justice and peace partners from academia, civil society, policy practitioners and religious society with valuable knowledge and skills necessary in the peace process that would enable them change their attitude of violence to non-violence.

2.2 Academic Regulations for the Programmes

2.2.1 Admission Requirements

- a) The Common Regulations for the Bachelor's degree programme in the University shall apply.
- b) The Common Regulations for all Bachelor degrees in the Centre for Social Justice and Ethics shall apply.
- c) The Centre will admit:
 - i) To the four-year programme, applicants with a minimum grade C Plain English, Kiswahili or any language offered in the Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education examination or its equivalent.
 - ii) To the three-year programme, applicants with a credit in English and Kiswahili or its equivalent in the Kenya Certificate of Education.
 - iii) A holder of any other qualification accepted by the Senate of the University equivalent to any of the above.
